From the Pastor...

"For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven," we read in Ecclesiastes. There is "a time to plant, and a time to pluck up what is planted... a time to break down, and a time to build up." Dietrich Bonhoeffer, a Lutheran pastor in Germany who suffered greatly under Hitler, applies this theme to the church. He speaks words of wisdom for our day. Read his words, which follow, and meditate upon them.

It is not we who build, (Christ) builds the church. No man builds the church but Christ alone. Whoever is minded to build the church is surely well on the way to destroying it; for he will build a temple to idols without wishing or knowing it. We must confess...He builds. We must pro-

claim...He builds. We must pray to Him...that He may build.

We do not know His plan. We cannot see whether He is building or pulling down. It may be that the times which by human standards are times of collapse, are for Him the great times of construction. It may be that the times which from a human point of view are great times for the church, are times when it is pulled down.

It is a great comfort which Christ gives to His church: you confess, preach, bear witness to Me, and I alone will build where it pleases Me. Do not meddle in what is My province. Do what is given to you to do well, and you have done enough. But do it well. Pay no heed to views and opinions. Don't ask for judgments. Don't always be calculating what will happen. Don't always be on the lookout for another refuge! Church, stay a church! But church, confess, confess, confess! Christ alone is your Lord; from His grace alone can you live as you are. Christ builds.

Lord Jesus Christ, the church's head, You are her one foundation; In You she trusts, before You bows, and waits for Your salvation. Built on this rock secure, Your Church shall endure Though all the world decay and all things pass away. O hear, O hear us, Jesus!



Golf Tournament Update

The Paul Ballmann Memorial Golf Tournament was held on August 12. The total profit from the tournament was \$25,389. This was divided evenly among the three beneficiaries; Jamie (Nadler) and Greg Kappelmann and their daughters, Stephanie Lindemann, a high school student from Union and a cancer victim, and the family of Eric Haddin, who died from a car accident. Thank you to all who helped or contributed!

Voters Meeting Recap

The Endowment Fund Committee reported \$10,370.70 in the First Bank Savings Account and \$201,767.00 in the LCMS account. Sausage Supper Committee reported 873 meals served, down 187 from last year, with a projected profit of \$9,940.48, about the same as last year, up \$1,000.00 from two years ago. Discussion followed about updates needed in building, equipment, and changes needed in operations next year. Golf Tournament yielded a \$25,000.00 profit with \$8,463 going to each beneficiary.

A new copy machine has been ordered from the Canon company at a cost of \$1,518.00. Officers were elected for 2018. Scott Jacob, vice-chairman, Bob Drier, one-year Elder, Dianne Pieper, Board Of Lay Ministry, Gordon Coates, Trustee. Positions not filled are Treasurer, Elder, Board Of Christian Education. The 2018 Budget was considered. Good debate followed over the salary raise included for the Pastor. The Elders' position was that Pastor has not received nor sought a raise in three years. and deserves one. This, plus the fact we are quite lower than synod guidelines, justifies the request. Opposing debate was that we simply cannot afford more expense being so far behind borrowing from the bank. Budget passed as proposed.

After reviewing the bylaws of the Endowment Fund intended expenditures, a motion passed to request the Endowment Fund Committee to reimburse the General Fund \$2,636.85 for the expense incurred last year in acquiring the donated Knoernschild property. Also to request \$1,518.00 for purchasing the replacement copy machine. A motion passed to place the Sausage Supper proceeds in the General Fund. Peter Menke volunteered to act as Lay Delegate to the District Convention in June in Columbia. Approved.
