From the Pastor...

December is a month of waiting. Children wait for December 25th to come when they can open the presents beneath the tree. For that to take place, parents had to wait in shopping lines in order to purchase those presents. Even if shopping is done online, parents wait for their packages to arrive.

December is a time of waiting also because of Advent. Advent means that we wait on God with eager expectation. Advent means more than just waiting for Christmas to come. Anyone can do this, and most do. We who belong to Jesus wait for His return with watchful anticipation. This does not mean that when we awake each morning, we remind ourself, "Today could be the day Jesus returns!" It's not bad to do this, but there is a different way in which we wait, as Jesus urges us to do when He says, "Watch, therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour" (Matthew 25:13). We wait with watchful hearts by receiving Christ as He comes to us now through His Word and His Sacraments.

The Apostle Paul informs us that when we come to Holy Communion, we "proclaim the Lord's death *until He comes.*" As we receive the Lord's body and blood, we are reminded in the words of the Sanctus that "all the company of heaven" celebrates with us. Though we come up to the Communion Table with both feet, we really have one foot in heaven when we commune. We receive the Christ who comes to us now in bread and wine, but we look forward with joyful anticipation to the day when we will be a part of that company of heaven and see Christ face to face. Monday through Saturday of each week, we wait for the Sacrament on Sunday. This waiting prepares us for the Final Day. Those who eagerly wait for Christ in bread and wine on Sunday are those who joyfully await His coming in the clouds of glory. It's Advent. This means we wait. But we wait with joy.
